### Tevi David Troy

Tevi Troy is Special Assistant to the President and Deputy Cabinet Secretary. He is also the White House liaison to the Jewish community. Previously, he was detailed to the White House from the Department of Labor as Special Advisor to the White House Domestic Policy Council. While at the Department of Labor, he was the Deputy Assistant Secretary for Policy, and previously served as Director of the Department of Labor's Office of Faith Based Initiatives.

Before joining the Bush Administration, Troy served as the Policy Director for Senator John Ashcroft, where he also handled Jewish liaison issues. From 1996 to 1998, Troy was Senior Domestic Policy Adviser and later Domestic Policy Director for the House Policy Committee, chaired by Christopher Cox. He has also served as the Herman Kahn Fellow at the Hudson Institute in Indianapolis and as a Researcher at the American Enterprise Institute in Washington.

A graduate of the Ramaz Upper School, Troy has a B.S. from Cornell University, an M.A. and Ph.D. in American Civilization from the University of Texas at Austin, and has studied at the London School of Economics. He is the author of Intellectuals and the American Presidency: Philosophers, Jesters, or Technicians (Lanham: Rowman and Littlefield, 2002). He has also written for numerous publications, including *The Wall Street Journal*, *The London Times Higher Education Supplement*, *The Washington Times*, *The Weekly Standard*, *National Review* and *Reason*. He is also the author of "My Boss the Fanatic," an article in *The New Republic* about John Ashcroft's relations with the Jews on his staff.

Troy is a member of the Kemp Mill Synagogue in Maryland, where he lives with his wife Kami and children, Ezra and Ruth.
